DEADLINE: Applications must be submitted:
Fall Semester – by September 1st
Spring Semester – by February 1st
Summer I Term – by June 12th
Summer II Term – by July 12th

PURPOSE: To provide supplemental financial assistance (up to \$500 per semester, \$250 per summer term) to those single parents who are at their income-earning potential. Scholarships may be used for tuition, books, utility bills, car maintenance, childcare, etc.

Applicants may re-apply for scholarship assistance each semester of study, but preference will be given to those beginning their academic careers. In general, we have many more applicants than we have scholarship money available

CRITERIA: Single parents selected for financial assistance will meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Resident of Randolph County, Arkansas
- ✓ High school graduate or equivalent (may apply if enrolled in college and in process of obtaining GED diploma)
- ✓ Single head of household (single, legally separated, divorced, or widowed)
- ✓ Pursuing an undergraduate course of study in a college or university (full-time or part-time) to ensure a better standard of living for his/her family. **Applicants cannot already have earned an undergraduate degree.**
- ✓ Low-income person at or near the poverty level
- ✓ Recipient of a Pell Grant or in process of obtaining same

	Three (3) <u>letters of recommendation</u> from people who are familiar with your character and goals. (Please <u>do not use relatives</u> as references.) <i>First time applicant's only, unless there is a major change in your goals.</i>
	A <u>personal statement</u> explaining the course of study you have selected, why you chose this particular course of study, and what you hope to achieve. Include any information about yourself which might be helpful to the Selection Committee in its evaluation.

Applications submitted without the required documents will be considered INCOMPLETE and ineligible for the scholarship.

Mary Sallee Single Parent Scholarship Program

WHAT is the Mary Sallee Single Parent Scholarship Program?

It is a Randolph County organization designed to provide scholarships to eligible men and women who wish to further their education at a two-year or four-year college. As an affiliate of the Arkansas Single Parent Scholarship Fund, the local program has the opportunity to receive up to \$10,000 annually in matching funds.

WHO is eligible?

- A resident of Randolph County pursuing or planning to pursue an undergraduate course of study in a college or university
- A single parent with sole custody of a minor child
- Income eligible (flexible requirements)

WHERE may an interested student apply?

Applications may be picked up at Black River Technical College, Williams Baptist College, or Arkansas State University.

WHEN may students apply?

Applications must be submitted:

- Fall Semester – by September 1
- Spring Semester – by February 1
- Summer I Term – by June 12
- Summer II Term – by July 12

WHY do we need a Single Parent Scholarship program?

Currently, 20% of Randolph County residents live in poverty. Many of these people are in single-parent households. Just as the late Mary Sallee advocated, we believe that education is the surest route to a fulfilling and productive life of independence.
