Single Parent Scholarship Fund of Clark County

CRITERIA

Single parents selected for financial assistance will meet the following criteria. They must be:

1. A resident of Clark County, Arkansas;
2. A high school or GED graduate;
3. A single head of household (single, legally separated, divorced, and widowed) with sole custody of one or more children under the age of 18;
4. Pursuing a career-oriented course of study (full time) to ensure a better standard of living for his/her family. Applicants cannot already have earned an undergraduate degree; with the exception of those pursuing a Master's Degree in Teaching/Education.
5. A low-income person at or near the poverty level;
6. A recipient of, or in the process of obtaining a Pell Grant.

THE PROGRAM

Is an affiliate of the Arkansas Single Parent Scholarship Fund (ASPSF) which is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization located in Springdale, AR. The objective of the ASPSF is to have a statewide affiliate scholarship program in every county in Arkansas. ASPSF provides up to \$7,000 per year in matching funds for each dollar raised or donated locally to support area scholarships.

ASPSF was made possible by a challenge grant from the Harvey and Bernice Jones Charitable Trust which permanently endowed over one million dollars to the fund in 2002.
